Walk the house, list what you find, and triage it. Most repairs are Tuesday problems, not emergencies.

Step 1: Triage what you found

Priority	Rule	Examples
Now	Safety or active water	Water you cannot stop, gas...
This week	Anything involving water	Stains, running toilets, f...
This month	Getting worse with use	Leaning fence post, draggi...
This season	Wear and comfort	Sticking doors, worn hardw...
Someday	Cosmetic only	Paint refresh, hardware up...

Step 3: DIY or pro?

- ☐ DIY-friendly: filters, flappers, caulk, hinges, nail holes, plunger work
- ☐ Call a pro: wiring beyond a fixture swap, plumbing behind walls, gas, roofs
- ☐ Call a pro: finish work that must disappear (texture, stain, sheen matching)
- ☐ Batch it: 3+ small jobs in one visit costs far less per task than separate calls
